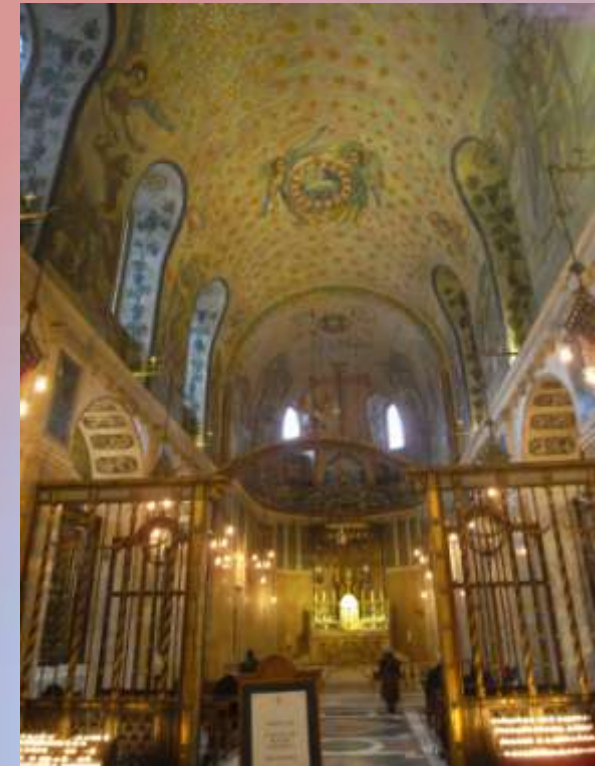
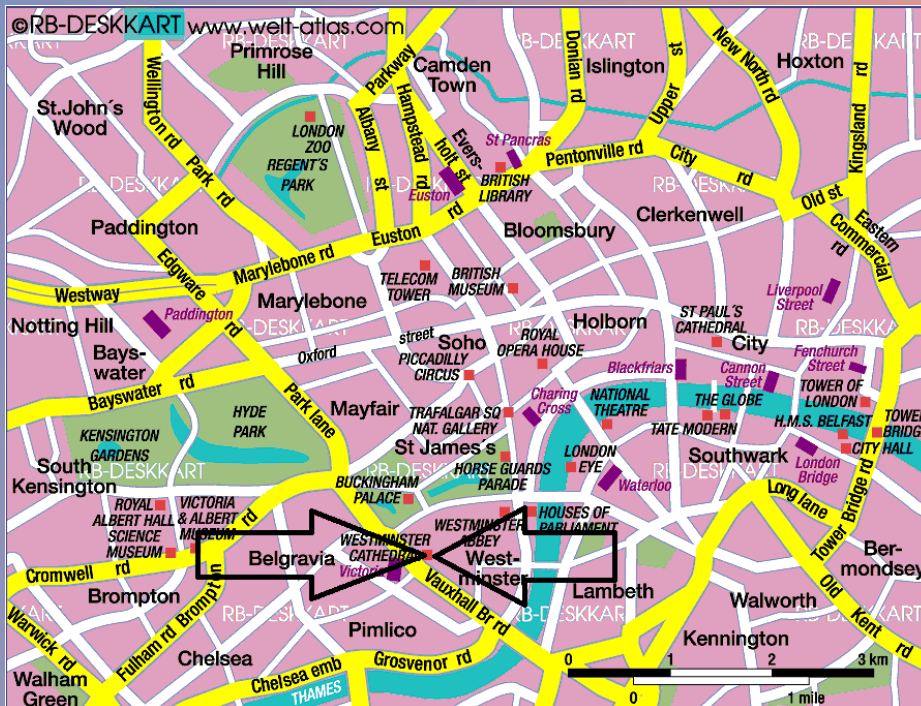


A photograph of Westminster Cathedral in London, showing its prominent red brick tower on the left and the main facade with a large archway at the bottom. The sky is overcast.

Westminster Cathedral



Westminster Cathedral in London is the mother church of the Catholic community in England and Wales and the Metropolitan Church and Cathedral of the Archbishop of Westminster. It is dedicated to the "Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ".





The cathedral is located in the City of Westminster. It is the largest Catholic church in England and Wales, and should not be confused with Westminster Abbey of the Church of England. Westminster Cathedral is the seat of the Archbishop.
